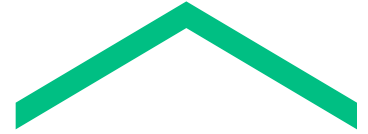

The Aldrich Contemporary Art Museum is looking for highly motivated and energetic individuals for the role of museum educator (“Educator”) to be responsible for leading in-gallery tours, hands-on workshops, and various educational programs for students, families, and adults. As an Educator, you will play a key role in delivering inquiry-based learning experiences that focus on contemporary art and fostering creative engagement across a range of audiences. Newly hired Educators will participate in a comprehensive training program (duration based on prior experience) with the Education staff focused on inquiry-based learning, contemporary art pedagogy, and group management techniques. In addition, exhibition-specific trainings will be scheduled throughout the year at the start of new exhibitions on view. Candidates must have flexible availability to lead programs during the week and on the occasional weekend.

Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:

- Lead in-gallery tours, discussions, and inquiry-based education programs.
- Collaborate in the development of lesson plans and education activities as needed.
- Support the preparation, setup, and breakdown of assigned programs including hands-on workshops and public programs.
- Support museum fundraising events as needed.
- Participate in exhibition trainings, department meetings, and professional development sessions.

Requirements and qualifications:

- Bachelor’s degree (BA/BFA) in art, art history, art education, or a related field, or equivalent professional experience.
- Avid interest in contemporary art.
- Experience in museum education, arts education, or classroom teaching experience is a plus.
- An understanding of object- and inquiry-based teaching practices is a plus.
- Ability to engage diverse age groups.

Compensation:

- Hourly wage of \$20 for per diem employment; 10 – 15 hours a month.
- Schedule: Per diem as needed, including occasional evening and weekend programs, to be coordinated with Manager of Education.
